KIMBALL ARTS FESTIVAL

August 6–8, 2010

The Kimball Art Center is set to host the annual Park City Kimball Arts Festival, one of the top art festivals in the country, in Park City, UT on August 6–8, 2010. More than 230 artists have been selected to participate in this annual juried show, featuring work in 12 categories. The three-day festival is anticipated to draw 45,000 attendees and including visual-art exhibitions, live musical performances, cuisine-related activities, art-focused film screening, as well as its largest fundraising event, The Park City Kimball Arts Festival Opening Night Gala and Auction.

Main Street, Heber Avenue, and Swede Alley are closed to vehicle traffic during the event. Other Old Town streets are closed to parking and can only be accessed to residents and businesses with an appropriate Access Pass

Limited paid parking is available in the south section of the China Bridge parking structure from the entrance on Marsac Avenue for \$10 (*cash only, please*).

Festival goers are strongly encouraged to use Park City's free bus system. Service is available 7:30am to midnight. The last bus leaves from the Transit Center to Kimball Junction at 9:55 p.m.

For an alternate route into Park City continue on I-80 to US-40 and take Exit 4 to UT Highway 248 (Kearns Blvd.). Kearns Blvd. and Bonanza Ave. have narrowed lanes due to construction. Please drive carefully.
